

Traffic Management: Short Guide & Site Map

Traffic standards

Site Speed limit: **20kph** max.
All vehicles: **Headlights on** (or daytime running-lights) when on site
Mobile plant: Use of a yellow flashing **beacon** and **reversing alarm**.
Pedestrians: Keep to **footpaths** and nominated accessways.
Do not use mobile devices when walking.

Follow traffic-flow instructions

Obey on-site road signage and markings
Follow traffic management plans. Updates/changes must be authorised and shared.

A way-finder escort is available by arrangement from the Gatehouse or via the Communications Centre.
If lost or unsure, STOP in a safe area and contact the Communications Centre for help.

Mobile plant:

Non-road legal mobile plant must be registered at the Permit Office before use.
(E.g. Sennebogans, excavators, loaders, etc)
Always carry out **pre-start checks** and ensure **defects** are closed-out before operation.

Reporting

Report Hazards, Close-calls, Incidents as soon as possible.
Advise your Port key-contact, or the Communications Centre.

Restricted Areas:

DO NOT ENTER any Restricted Area where you do not have permission.
Contact the company in control of the area. Contact information displayed at area access point.
